EQUINE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Occupancy:

- Double equestrian camping site pricing includes 2 adults and their dependent children, and up to 2 horses.

E1 Campers:

- Campers are to clean up after their horses throughout the park, including trails.
- Campers who leave horse waste behind are subject to a \$100 clean up fee.
- All stalls/sites must be left clean.
- All unused hay must be cleaned up and removed.
- Equestrian campers are required to sign the Policy and Procedures upon check in. _____

Standards of Care:

- Management is not held responsible for the care, clean-up, and well-being of campers horses.
- Campers are responsible for any actions or needs related to their horses.
- Management reserves the right to remove any horse and/or camper and cancel a reservation if they suspect negligence. _____

Horses are not permitted to ride on the trails within the park, there are marked trails available with access from the park. G2G Trail, Robertson Trail etc. Maps available at the store.

Horses are allowed to ride in and out of the park to and from the Equestrian Sites but are otherwise not permitted to ride within the park, including Main St, the playground, pool, elk, or dog park area.

Equestrian campers must be courteous of other pedestrian or bicycling campers.

Manure Disposal: Please ensure that all manure is disposed of in the provided location or taken with you upon check out. Clean up fees will be applied if needed.

All Riders must wear a certified ASTM riding helmet.
